Car Triangle with Exclamation Point BMW E90 Car Triangle with Exclamation Point; The exclamation point in the yellow triangle that lights up on the dashboard of BMW cars is also known as the generic warning light or the service light. If this light came on the dashboard panel of your car, it usually indicates that it is not an emergency, but that there is a problem in your car that needs to be fixed. The color changes from white for a benign message, to yellow, needs attention, to red, critical. Click for detailed information: Door Open Warning Light BMW E90 Door open warning light; A warning lamp that lights up when an individual door is open or closed, including luggage in your car. Swing Gate Reminder Warning Light BMW E90 Swing gate reminder warning light; Signs with vehicle dashboard which mean that the luggage compartment is open. Hood Open Warning Light BMW E90 Hood Open Warning Light; If the engine hood is open, this vehicle warning light will appear on the panel Service Electric Parking Warning Light BMW E90 Service Electric Parking Warning Light; This warning symbol alerts you that there is a technical problem/defect in the parking brake system and needs emergency service. All Wheel Drive Warning Light BMW E90 All Wheel Drive Warning Light; If this instrument cluster warning symbol illuminates, it indicates a problem with the AWD system. It would be best to take your vehicle to your service provider. Steering Wheel Warning Light BMW E90 Steering Wheel Warning Light; In vehicles with hydraulic and / or electric steering systems, problems and failures that occur in the system can be seen on the instrument panel with the red steering wheel mark on the instrument panel. Water in Fuel Filter Warning Light BMW E90 Water in Fuel Filter Warning Light; This motor warning light indicates that the water level in the fuel filter has increased. Loose Fuel Filler Cap Warning Light BMW E90 Loose Fuel Filler Cap Warning Light; Check the fuel cap Low washer fluid warning light BMW E90 Low washer fluid warning light; Car warning light informing the user that the windshield washer liquid has decreased or run out. Service Adaptive Cruise Control Warning Light BMW E90 Service adaptive cruise control warning light; ACC is currently not available. When safe, stop the vehicle and turn off the engine. Restart the vehicle and check the radar for dirt, ice, etc. Check for obstructions. If the warning lamp stays on, please visit your nearest authorized service facility for assistance. Traction Off Light BMW E90 Traction off light; Most traction control systems illuminate the warning light when the system detects a loss of traction, such as in snow or rain. Typically, the light is seen when the system intervenes to maintain traction. It's a good idea to read the chapter in your car owner's manual to familiarize yourself with how your traction or stability system works. If the traction control light comes on and stays on without flashing, it means that the traction control system is disabled and there is no traction control. A message may even be issued by the driver information centre, warning that the traction control system has been switched off and that extra care must be exercised, especially when driving on water, ice and snow. The only way to properly resolve any of the above conditions is to properly diagnose the vehicle at a qualified repair shop. Always have the repair shop do a full computer system scan. Electronic Stability Control Off Warning Light BMW E90 Electronic stability control off warning light; The ESC system does not work the same in all vehicles. That's why it's always important to consult your manufacturer's manual to understand how yours works. Generally, the ESC light illuminates when the vehicle loses control and stays on when a malfunction is detected or the system is turned off manually. Tire Pressure Monitoring System Tpms Warning Light BMW E90 Tire pressure monitoring system tpms warning light; The tire pressure in your car is low or there is a problem in the system. Click for detailed information: Lane Departure Warning Light BMW E90 Lane Departure Warning Light; The lane change light means that it is detected that the vehicle is leaving its current lane without signaling. It can help keep you in your lane. Smart Entry System Indicator Light BMW E90 Smart Entry System Indicator Light; Indicates a malfunction in the smart entry & start system or The warning lamp informs that the ignition key is faulty. Lane Depature Warning Light BMW E90 Lane depature warning light; It is a warning lamp that lights up when the lane change is made without using the signal in the vehicles produced by today's technology. Suspension Control Warning Light BMW E90 Suspension Control Warning Light; This warning light will appear if the suspension system fails. Automatic Gearbox Warning Light BMW E90 Automatic gearbox warning light; If there is a problem with the automatic transmission, this warning light is lit in yellow or red on the instrument panel. If the emergency warning lamp is illuminated when the emergency warning lamp ON, carefully drive the vehicle in the P, R, N, D (forward gears only 3rd and 5th gears) works. It is recommended that you drive your car at low speed and enter the nearest authorized service station. Collision Mitigating Braking System Warning Light BMW E90 Collision mitigating braking system warning light; The light comes on when the system is turned off, when the radar sensor is dirty or clogged, or when there is a malfunction in the system. In the last case, take the vehicle to your dealer or authorized workshop for diagnosis and repair. Blind Spot Indicator Light BMW E90 Blind spot indicator light; This light illuminates when a vehicle or obstacle is detected in your blind spot. Pre sense warning light BMW E90 Pre sense warning light; Pre Sense, uses sensors that trigger the electronic stability control system when the driver applies the brake forcefully. In turn, electric motors tighten or tighten the front seat belts in preparation for a possible accident. In addition, Basic turns on the hazard warning flashers, closes the windows and closes the sunroof (if equipped). This version of Pre Sense does not help the driver avoid collision. Instead, it prepares the cabin for impact to reduce the chance of serious injury should it occur. Hill Descent Control Warning Light BMW E90 Hill descent control warning light; If the hill descent control indicator light is steady ON, the system is ON and armed and is controlling the vehicle speed. If the hill descent control indicator light is flashing, the system is ON but is not activated and is not controlling vehicle speed. Turn Signal Indicator Light BMW E90 Turn signal indicator light; Indicates that the signal is on. When you lower the signal arm, the left turn indicates the right turn when you lift it up. Service Stop Start System Warning Light BMW E90 Service stop start system warning light; Many new car models are equipped with engine stop/start, which helps save fuel by turning your engine off when you're at a red light. This warning light will appear if there's something wrong with this system. Cruise Control Indicator Light BMW E90 Cruise control indicator light; Indicator light to indicate that the cruise control is activated. Headlight On Indicator Light BMW E90 Headlight on indicator light; It indicates that the short headlamps and stop lights are on. Dipped Head Lights BMW E90 Dipped head lights; This sign appears on the front panel when the short headlights are on High Beam Indicator Light Warning Light BMW E90 High beam indicator light warning light; Indicates that the long beamed headlights are on. Fuel Filter Warning Light BMW E90 Fuel filter warning light; A warning light that indicates that the fuel filter is dirty or worn. You must clean or replace the fuel filter as soon as possible. Attention please ! These dashboard symbols might appear as different colours but they should be looked at when it is safe. A vehicle's dashboard helps drivers stay safe on the road by letting them know something needs attention. Not all symbols are universal.
