## How to clean american standard jetted tub

Can you put bath bombs in a jetted tub? "We have so many plants that drop seeds, leaves and dirt into our jet tub. Only use one or the other and do not mix them. Sprinkle a generous amount of baking soda inside the tub, let it sit for several minutes, and then use the soft, dampened cloth to scrub away the grime. Turn on the jets for 10 minutes. Conveniently, you can also use the baking soda on the faucet and drain too. Pour in an amount of the cleaning liquid specified by the product's instructions. Drain the Tub. The best way to keep mold away is to keep the tub as clean and dry as possible when it is not in use and to reduce the relative humidity of your bathroom after the tub has been used. Biofilm removal liquids are designed specifically to clean away all the gunk that accumulates inside the plumbing of a jetted tub.[6] Biofilm is a natural film that is created by the buildup of bacteria, mold, mildew, and other biological materials. Pour a tablespoon of liquid hand dish-washing detergent -- do not use powdered -- on a damp, clean sponge. Cold water is fine for the second cycle because you are just going to give the jets a final rinse. As a general rule, don't add bubbles, shampoos or soaps to a jetted tub. Add the Cleaning Agent. You can use an old toothbrush to get into the crevices of the jets if there is anything lodged in them still after cleaning. Never use both bleach and vinegar together. 5 Run the jets at full capacity for 10-15 minutes. Some manufacturers suggest you do not use bleach because it can dry out the internal gaskets of your tub. Use a clean rag to wipe away any residue that is left on the surface of the tub. Manufacturers of whirlpool tubs recommend regular flushing of the jet system to reduce the accumulation of bacteria and soap scum in the jetted tub's water lines. 3 Add the specified amount of biofilm remover to the water and turn the jets on. Fill the tub up to 2-3 in (5.1-7.6 cm) above the jets again, but with cold water this time. How to Clean Jetted Tubs With Bleach Fill up the tub until the jets are covered at least 3" of water. Let them run for at least three minutes, or longer if you're seeing bits of build-up in the water. This forces the water to circulate only in the internal plumbing of the tub to concentrate the flow and clean deeper. Turn off your hot tub. Drain the water from the tub. To deep clean mold and mildew, do the above steps using bleach instead of vinegar. Check your owner's manual. Take the bath mat out of the tub after each use and hang until it's dry. The filter in a jetted tub is responsible for removing contaminants that may lessen the quality of the tub's water. Wash the jets. Scrub the acrylic surface with this sponge. dishwasher liquid like ( Cascade) Use 4 tsp (56.7 g) of powdered dish detergent if you don't have liquid detergent.[3] The detergent will loosen greasy residue left behind in the jets by soap or bubble bath liquid.
