This list covers some of the world's most renowned classical music pieces, complete with background information. Mozart's Serenade No. 13 for strings in G major has become incredibly popular, featuring in films like Charlie's Angels - Full Throttle and TV programs. The piece was given its nickname by Mozart himself, and it has also been featured prominently in the film Amadeus about his life. While we don't know who "Elise" is, we can agree that this piece is one of the most charming piano compositions ever written. Read more: Beethoven's 20 Greatest Works of All Time Puccini's 'O mio babbino caro' from his opera Gianni Schicchi has become famous for its romantic melody. It features on soundtracks like Downton Abbey and Captain Correll's Mandolin, among others. Read more: The 15 Most Famous Opera Songs and Arias Bach's Toccata and Fugue in D minor is instantly recognizable due to its opening notes, which have become synonymous with scary moments in horror films. This piece has even featured in pop songs! Read more: The 15 Greatest Symphonies of All Time The Four Seasons, a series of four violin concertos composed by Antonio Vivaldi, gives musical expression to each season. The concertos have become incredibly popular, with "Winter" being used as a ringtone and featured in various adaptations. On the other hand, Bizet's opera Carmen was initially met with controversy due to its risqué plot but has since become one of the most successful operas ever written. Its catchy tunes, such as the "Toreador's Song" and "Habanera," have been used in numerous films, TV shows, and advertisements. The Blue Danube, a waltz by Johann Strauss II, is an unofficial national anthem for Austria and was famously featured in Stanley Kubrick's 2001: A Space Odyssey. Ravel's music was originally composed as a ballet but gained widespread recognition after being used in Torvill and Dean's 1984 Olympic ice skating routine. The "Flower Duet" from Léo Delibes' opera Lakmé is another extremely well-known piece, often interpreted by different artists. It has been featured in various advertisements, including a memorable British Airways commercial. Edvard Grieg's Peer Gynt Suite was originally written for Ibsen's play and later adapted into two suites, with the main theme being incredibly catchy and widely used in pop music, TV shows, and advertisements. The melody from this suite has also been featured in films like Willy Wonka and the Chocolate Factory. Mozart's Marriage of Figaro is one of the most frequently performed operas, telling a story about Figaro and Susanna's wedding plans being put to test by various obstacles. The opera features Mozart - The Marriage of Figaro Overture (K.492) performed by Wiener Symphoniker under Fabio Luisi, which is widely known and admired. Puccini's 'Nessun dorma' was first featured in Turandot, but became famous after being used for the 1990 World Cup in Italy by Luciano Pavarotti, and later by Andrea Bocelli at The Global Awards 2018. Prokofiev's Romeo and Juliet ballet has a centerpiece music piece that's quite dramatic and was even chosen as theme music for The Apprentice TV series, showing its impact on audiences... Rossini's William Tell Overture Final has a recognisable galloping rhythm and trumpet solos that were used in The Lone Ranger films and TV shows, but it's now somewhat of a cliché soundtrack for action sequences.
