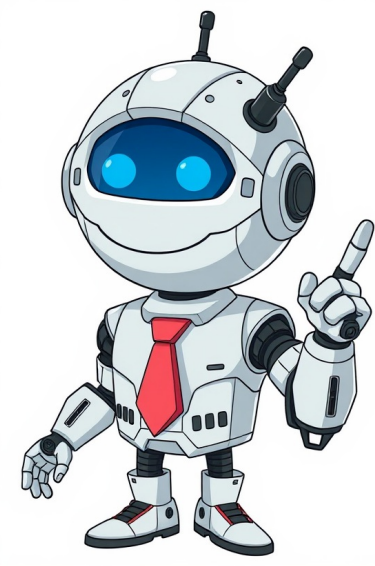

Grille is a noun.
