paraphrased text here eirēnē is a Greek word signifying peace, encompassing both literal and figurative meanings, with related connotations of prosperity.[12] The Bible describes eirēnē as harmony, security, and salvation, which can be applied to individual or national levels. In Christianity, it signifies one's belief in achieving salvation before or after death. Moreover, eirēnē denotes a state of wholeness and order versus chaos.[13] Christians associate Jesus with the Prince of Peace, as described in Isaiah 9.[14] who brings peace to those seeking it. In John 14:27, Jesus reassures his followers that he leaves them with "peace I give," distinct from the world's offering, which encourages their hearts not to be troubled or fearful.[15] Historically, eirēnē referred to a person capable of avenging themselves yet chose not to. The Greek scriptures frequently use eirēnē to describe faith, both as a trustworthy and those believing in God and Jesus Christ are linked by this concept.[24] The writer of the Letter to the Hebrews illustrates it with the example of Jesus enduring the cross for joy's sake.[25] Gentleness or meekness operates through faith as a divinely-balanced virtue, while gentleness is characterized by being even-tempered and tranquil.[26] The Greek term enkrateia signifies self-control, mastery over one's thoughts and behavior, particularly in strength.
